Annual Meeting Minutes of the MN Hereford Breeders Friday, December 12, 2014 McLeod County Fairgrounds, Hutchinson, MN.

The meeting was called to order by President Daryl Rupprecht. The Secretary's Report was given by Ross Carlson; he read the 2013 minutes. A motion was made by John Pettit and second by Kory Kruse to accept the minutes as read. The Treasurer's Report was hand out, and a motion to accept by Chad Williamson and seconded by Steve Kruse.

Old Business:

Fall Tour report was given by Less Krogstad. 80+ people attended.

AHA delegate report was given by Jim Hanson and Ross Carlson. The newly elected board members are Jim Mickelson, Kevin Schultz, and Bob Thompson.

Minnesota Beef Expo report was given by Steve Kruse. 705 head were shown on Sunday in the Junior show. Herefords were the 4th largest show. 309 participants in showmanship and 38 judging teams competed. Hereford heifers averaged \$2571.00 in the sale, 2 Hereford steers averaged \$3350.00 in the sale. MYBEP had a lot of requests for Hereford heifers. J&J Hanson Herefords donated this year's MYBEP heifer which was awarded to Shiane Teas from Aitkin, MN. Next year's heifer will come from Whispering Pine Farms of Kimball, MN.

State Fair report was covered by President Daryl Rupprecht where he thanked Kent, Dave, Bonnie, and Jeri for their work.

AGA report was given by Levi Landers. He explained the catalog mistake on the mailing addresses and other details. He offered a discount to make up for error. He proposed free banner ads for next year's sale, post card mailing next year and catalog next year. Levi then reported on the AHA statistics of registrations, cow inventory, and CHB growth.

New Business:

Cow-Calf Days by Kory Kruse, will be help 2-9-15 through 2-20-15. The U of M Beef Team circulates our booth and literature. Our membership decided to stay at the Silver level (\$1000.00). Sponsorship motion by Jim Hanson and seconded by Shawn Eckert.

New Directory: Levi stated they need 30 days for the layout. Page prices: \$250 base price. Motion made by Brad Hemman, seconded by Kyle Kuelbs. Commercial ads are \$400 with a \$25 credit to members who sell commercial ads.

Banquet: John Pettit stated we should let the board set the banquet ticket cost, but make the banquet pay for itself.

Election: The three newly elected returning board members are Jared Flower, Kory Kruse, and Dale Bellefy.

Final business ended with Alan Dose mentioning that the web page needs to be updated.

A motion was made to adjourn the meeting by Shawn Eckert, and seconded by Jim Griffenow.

President Daryl Rupprecht called the meeting to order at 12:45 pm. The Secretary's Report from the Annual Meeting in December was reviewed. A motion was made by Kory Kruse and second by Jerry Delaney to approve the minutes as written. The Treasurer's Report was reviewed by discussion. A note was made to mail \$1000 to Les Krogstad for the 2014 Tour expenses. A motion was made by Dale Bellefy and second by Jerry Delaney to approve the report.

Old Business:

Discussion on the GoPher Sale given by Steve Wolff. 2014 GoPher sale expense was 16%, which is much less than many other sales. All pictures were taken free of charge. Also, Logan Hoffmann from DVAucion donated some time to lower the videoing cost. AHA also donated to lower the cost of the catalog. The committee discussed concerns on how to keep our consignors, and the possibility of combining sales with other breeds. Steve noted he will not beg for cattle on next year's sale. The committee has concerns about needing more numbers on the sale. Everyone has to try to get more people to consign. Deadlines are very important for advertising and organizing the sale. Pens for cattle are a huge benefit. It was decided to keep Jason McDonald's panel trailer at someone's place, it would be parked there for the year and we will use it at the GoPher. We need 50+ panels to continue what we are doing now to set up.

New Business:

State Tour – No tour for 2015. Next tour will be in 2016. Discussion was on Dose Herefords and other breeders in that area.

State Fair 4-H Auction – Nothing to add, they are working on the auction. Jerry Delaney noted it would be nice to have a lock-in sponsor every year for Champion Hereford steer. Jason McDonald can talk to some people to try to get that done. \$2500-\$4000. Whoever sponsors this needs to be on every advertising publication through the year (websites, newsletters, back page of directory, etc.) It was also noted that the \$50 per Hereford animal at State Fair encourages members to join the MN Hereford Breeders.

Website updating - It needs to get done. It has cost \$300 per year to maintain in the past. Kory Kruse made a motion for Jared and Makayla Flower to maintain the website for \$400 per year. Second by Jason McDonald.

Newsletters: Three issues per year: June, August, and November.

Junior Donation Heifer – Steve Wolff will not find the heifer again this year. Daryl Rupprecht will do some checking.

President Daryl Rupprecht asked if there was a motion to adjourn the meeting. Kory Kruse made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Second by Jared Flower.
