

## 2023 General Rules

1. Entries are due **June 2<sup>nd</sup>** (\$50/head). Late fees will apply for entries made June 3<sup>rd</sup> and after (\$70/hd)
2. All entries must be made online at: <https://form.jotform.com/231365064430145>
3. Please fill out 1 form per exhibitor
4. Bred & Owned Heifer Show - \$15/head when also shown in the Owned Show. If only showing in the B&O Show \$50/hd (and late entry fee of \$70/hd applies)
5. Late entries will be accepted until 11am on June 17<sup>th</sup> (\$70/head) provided space is available
6. The Entry Fee includes barn bedding
7. Tie-outs are available at no cost; bedding *may* also be included; an email will be sent to exhibitors the week of the show when we know if we will have enough bedding to do this.
8. Cattle may begin arriving in the afternoon of Friday, June 17<sup>th</sup>
9. Cattle must be checked in by **11a.m. on Saturday, June 18<sup>th</sup>**
10. Heifers, Bulls, and Cows must have original registration papers at time of check-in
11. Bulls **must be bred and owned by the junior (not a family/ranch/farm name)**
12. Heifers in the Bred & Owned Heifer classes must be bred and owned by the junior (not a family/ranch/farm name), there will be a \$15/hd fee is also showing in the Owned show. If only showing in B&O standard entry fees apply
13. Calves shown as part of a Cow/Calf pair must pay a separate entry fee if you wish to exhibit the calf as an individual. If the calf is bred and owned the B&O rules apply (see above)
14. Steers must have original AHA Steer Certificate or Pedigree at time of check-in
15. Steer classes will be split at the discretion of the committee based on entries and weights
16. Health papers will be check by an accredited veterinarian at time of check-in. All animals must meet MN state health requirements.
17. All tattoos must be legible, if not the animal(s) will be disqualified for exhibition.
18. Horned and polled cattle will show together.
19. Exhibitors must show their own animals unless an exhibitor has more than one entry in a class
20. Fitting of animals is allowed for all classes except showmanship
21. Showmanship divisions are as follows, based on your age as of January 1, 2023
  - a. Senior (18-21)
  - b. Intermediate (14-17)
  - c. Junior (10-13)
  - d. Pee Wee (9 & Under)
22. All exhibitors will be listed on the Showmanship form in the Show Arena by age division. If you wish not to participate in showmanship please cross your name off by **NOON** on Saturday as class breaks in each division will be made at that time.
23. All persons making entries in the show agree to abide by all the rules and regulations as outlines above and by the American Hereford Association (AHA) and will not hold the AHA, Pipestone County, Minnesota Junior Hereford Breeders (MJHB) or the 2023 Midwest Classic Hereford Show or its organizers responsible for accident, loss, or injury to any person, animal, or article.
24. All persons attending the event are required to comply with all federal, state, and local rules and regulations. By entering to participate, EACH participant hereby waives, discharges, forgives, ad releases any and all claims again the AHA, Pipestone County, MJHB, and the Midwest Classic Hereford Show or its officials, officers, directors, employees, and agents related to COVID-19 virus, including infections, illness, disease, injury, or death related to COVID-19, resulting from participation or attendance at the 2023 Midwest Classic.
