

2022 General Rules

1. Entries are due **June 1st** (\$50/head).
2. All entries must be made online at: <https://form.jotform.com/221325920300036>
3. Please fill out 1 form per exhibitor
4. Bred & Owned Heifer Show \$15/head when also shown in the Owned Show. If only showing in B&O Show \$50/hd and late entry fee applies
5. Late entries will be accepted until 11a.m. on June 25th (\$70/head), provided space is available
6. The Entry Fee includes barn bedding.
7. Tie-outs are available at no cost, bedding is not provided for tie-outs
8. Cattle may begin arriving on Friday, June 24th
9. Cattle must be checked-in by **11a.m. on Saturday, June 25th**
10. Heifers, Bulls, and Cows must have original registration papers at time of check-in.
11. Bulls **must be bred and owned by the junior (not a family/ranch/farm name)**
12. Heifers in the Bred & Owned Heifer classes must be bred and owned by the junior (not a family/ranch/farm name), there will be a \$15/hd fee if also showing in the Owned Show. If only showing in B&O standard entry fees apply.
13. Calves shown as part of a Cow/Calf pair must pay a separate entry fee if you wish to exhibit the calf as an individual.
14. Steers must have original AHA Steer Certificate or Pedigree at time of check-in.
15. Steer classes will be split at the discretion of the committee based on entries and weights.
16. Health papers will be checked by an accredited veterinarian at time of check-in.
All animals must meet MN state health requirements.
10. All tattoos must be legible, if not the animal(s) will be disqualified for exhibition.
11. Horned and Polled cattle will show together.
12. Exhibitors must show their own animals unless an exhibitor has more than one entry in a class.
13. Exhibitors must use their own animals for showmanship
14. Fitting of animals is allowed for all classes except showmanship.
15. Showmanship divisions are as follows, based on your age as of January 1, 2022.
 1. Senior (18-21)
 2. Intermediate (14-17)
 3. Junior (10-13)
 4. Pee Wee (9 and under)
16. All exhibitors will be listed on the Showmanship form in the Show Arena by age division. If you wish not participate in showmanship please cross your name off by **1p.m.** on Saturday as class breaks in each division will be made at that time.
17. All persons making entries in the show agree to abide by all the rules and regulations as outlined above and by the American Hereford Association and will not hold the American Hereford Association, Minnesota Junior Hereford Breeders or the 2022 Midwest Classic Hereford Show or its organizers responsible for accident, loss, or injury to any person, animal, or article.
18. All persons attending the event are required to comply with all federal, state, and local rules and regulations related to COVID-19. By entering to participate, EACH participant hereby waives, discharges, forgives, and releases any and all claims against the American Hereford Association, Pipestone County, Minnesota Junior Hereford Breeders, and Midwest Classic Hereford Show or its officials, officers, directors, employees, and agents related to COVID-19 virus, including any infection, illness, disease, injury, or death related to COVID-19, resulting from participation or attendance at the 2022 Midwest Classic.
